BASED ON THE CRITERIA USED IN LEED-NC 2.2, DETERMINE WHETHER A PAINT PRODUCT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS TO BE CONSIDERED A "GREEN PRODUCT". USING ESTABLISHED TECHNICAL DATA, YOU WILL BE ABLE TO INCORPORATE TEST RESULTS TO AID IN PROJECTING THE LIFE CYCLE AND DOLLAR-COST ANALYSIS OF A PAINT PRODUCT. THOUGH THE UNDERSTANDING OF TEST RESULTS, YOU WILL BE ABLE TO EFFECTIVELY COMMUNICATE HOW A PAINT PRODUCT RELATES TO YOUR ON-GOING SUSTAINABLE GOALS.
